## How to get and use Mobile Driver's Licenses and Mobile IDs

# **Apple Wallet**

Adding a license or state ID to Apple Wallet can be done in a few easy steps. Residents can tap the Add (+) button at the top of the screen in Wallet on their iPhone, select "Driver's License or State ID," and follow the onscreen instructions to start the setup and verification process.

# **Google Wallet**

Add your ID to Google Wallet in just a few steps for an easy and secure way to store and show your ID. Tap 'Add to Wallet' in the Google Wallet app, select 'ID card', then your state, and follow the verification steps with your physical ID.

#### Presenting a Mobile ID in a Secure, Private Way

## Presenting an ID in Apple Wallet

Users can securely present their New Mexico driver's license or state ID in Apple Wallet in person and in apps to show proof of age or identity. IDs in Apple Wallet use the privacy and security features that are built into Apple devices to help protect a user's identity and personal information. When adding an ID to Apple Wallet, the MVD receives only the information it needs to approve or deny the request.

Once an ID is added to Apple Wallet, the information is encrypted on a user's device, so others cannot access it unless a user chooses to present it. Apple and the MVD do not know when or to whom a user presents their driver's license or state ID.

When presenting in-person, users can go to Apple Wallet and select their ID. From there, they can hold their mobile device near an identity reader, review the specific information being requested, and use Face ID or Touch ID to authenticate before the requested information is shared. Users do not need to show, or hand over their device to present their ID.

When presenting an ID in apps, users can select the "Verify with Apple Wallet" or "Continue with Apple Wallet" button. From there, they can review the specific information being requested, and authenticate with Face ID or Touch ID before the requested information is shared.

#### Presenting an ID in Google Wallet

Safety and security are built into every part of Google Wallet, including IDs. When you add a state issued ID or driver's license to Google Wallet, your information is stored encrypted on your Android device and can be used to verify your identity or age.

When presenting your digital ID in person, make sure Bluetooth is turned on and hold it near the reader for verification. Your data will only be shared once you've authenticated your device, through biometrics or a pin. Before showing your ID, review and confirm

the details on your Android device. At no point should you have to hand your phone over to present your digital ID. Information about who you share your ID with is only visible to you and not to MVD or Google.

Some apps and websites may also accept your ID in Google Wallet online as part of their verification process. Just like in-person, you will review and confirm the details on your phone before sharing.

Google Wallet keeps your state ID protected with advanced security, so your personal details stay safe. If your phone is stolen or lost, your ID can be deleted with remotely from myaccount.google.com
